Science—Plants

What grows in your garden?

We will be identifying and naming a variety of common plants and looking at the basic structure of flowering plants and trees.

Maths

Place Value

We will work on:

Understanding the place value of numbers to 100 including partitioning numbers into tens and ones.

Count in steps of 2,3, 5 and 10.

Reading and writing numbers in words and numerals to 100, comparing and ordering numbers.

Addition and Subtraction

Recall number bonds to 10 and 100.

Add and subtract from and across 10, find 10 more/10 less.

Geography

What can I see through my window?

We will be exploring the local area and identifying geographical features. We will devise our own maps and carry out surveys where we collect and interpret data.

RE– Christianity - Why do Christians say that God is the Father?

We will look at why Christians refer to God as the Father and relate this to our own families. We will look at how and why Christians pray to God.

Music– Pulse and Rhythm

We will be learning what pulse and rhythm are and how pieces of music are made up of different parts.

PSHE– Health and Well Being

What is the same and different about us?

We will be looking at our own personal qualities and how we are all unique. We will be naming different body parts and looking at how we keep our bodies safe.
