Billy and the Minpins by Roald Dahl—Setting Description

Children will use adjectives and prepositions in their sentences to create a description of a scene from the story Billy and the Minpins.

Billy and the Minpins by Roald Dahl—Diary entry.

Children will immerse themselves into the story of Billy and the Minpins to create a diary entry from the point of view of one of the characters. Children will develop their sentences by applying conjunctions to create compound and multi-clause sentences.

Science

Animals including humans—digestion

Children will investigate what happens to our food once we have eaten it. They will explore the importance of our teeth in this process, why it is important to look after them and how our diet is different to that of other animals.

Maths

Place Value Children will use place value to represent, partition and complete number lines up to 1,000.

Addition and Subtraction Children will be adding and subtracting 1, 10, and 100 to a given number. Children will progress to adding and subtracting up to 3 digit numbers with and without exchanges.

Geography

Why do people like to visit the Lake District?

Children will compare and contrast the Lake District with Burnley in terms of geographical location and land use. We will explore the physical and human features of both locations and the differences in how they generate income. We will finish exploring tourism in the Lake District.

French

This is Me

Children will recognise and respond to different greetings, form phrases to say hello and introduce themselves as well as to practice the correct pronunciation of the French phonemes. Ask someone how they are feeling and write phrases in French.

PE

Invasion games— Children will be looking at passing and shooting balls with accuracy, dodging, tactical play and moving into space.

RE—Why is the Prophet

Muhammad (pbuh) an example for Muslims?

Children will identify characteristics of good role models and how The Prophet (PBUH) displayed them.

Music—Samba music

Children will explore percussion instruments through the context of Brazilian carnival. They will experiment with the typical structures of Samba music used in Carnival to create their own piece of music.

PSHE

Why should we eat well and look after our teeth?

Children will analyse balanced lifestyles, understanding what food choices we make and how these may be influenced. They will look at how to maintain good oral hygiene.

Computing

How to stay safe online

Children will be exploring how we can stay safe whilst using electrical devices. We will look at how to treat others with respect and how not to trust all we can see online. Children will also investigate implications of spending too long online.

DT

Pneumatics

Children will explore how air can be used in different mechanisms to cause movement. They will experiment with different sized syringes and connecting these using pipes to create a creature in a box toy.
