

Science

Animals including humans—digestion

Children will investigate what happens to our food once we have eaten it. They will explore the importance of our teeth in this process, why it is important to look after them and how our diet is different to that of other animals.

Geography

Why do people like to visit the Lake District?

Children will compare and contrast the Lake District with Burnley in terms of geographical location and land use. We will explore the physical and human features of both locations and the differences in how they generate income. We will finish exploring tourism in the Lake District.

RE

Why is the Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) an example for Muslims?

Children will identify characteristics of good role models and how the Prophet displayed them.

Music

Music—Samba music

Children will explore percussion instruments through the context of Brazilian carnival. They will experiment with the typical structures of Samba music used in Carnival to create their own piece of music.

English

Historic Novel—The Wreck of the Zanzibar-Children will learn to use a range of sentence openers in writing, including: conjunctions and adverbials. Expanded noun phrases will also be explored to add detail to sentences. Children will write an adventure based on our novel.

Poetry—The Pied Piper of Hamelin-Children will explore the poem and interpret it through storyboards and recitals. Children will also write their own verse in a similar style to the original.

Curriculum



PSHE

Why should we eat well and look after our teeth?

Children will analyse balanced lifestyles, understanding what food choices we make and how these may be influenced. They will look at how to maintain good oral hygiene.

Computing

How to stay safe online

Children will be exploring how we can stay safe whilst using electrical devices. We will look at how to treat others with respect and how not to trust all we can see online. Children will also investigate implications of spending too long online.

Maths

Place Value Children will use place value to represent, partition and complete number lines up to 10,000.

Addition and Subtraction Children will be adding and subtracting 1, 10, 100 and 1000 to a given number. Children will progress to adding and subtracting up to 4 digit numbers with and without exchanges.

French

This is Me

Children will recognise and respond to different greetings, form phrases to say hello and introduce themselves as well as to practice the correct pronunciation of the French phonemes. Ask someone how they are feeling and write phrases in French.

PE

Invasion Games - Tag Rugby

Children will be learning the fundamentals of passing and catching before moving onto exploring strategies to work as a team to attack and defend.
