

English

Classic Narrative—The Railway Children

Children will read extracts of the book and discuss the language used. They will infer the thoughts and feelings of the characters. Children will then write a diary entry as a character from the book.

Discussion text—Social media

Is social media a positive or negative influence? Children will explore the issue through research and discussions/debates. They will then write up their findings as a formal discussion text.

History

How has the early Islamic civilisation influenced the wider world?

Children will know about the impact that the Islamic ancient civilization had on the world and know why they were considered an advanced society in relation to that period of time in Europe .

RE

Why is the Qur'an so important to Muslims?

They will explore and examine the origins and role of the Qur'an as a source of wisdom and authority for Muslims. They will study the importance of revelation within Islam and how this impacts on the way that the Qur'an is viewed and treated.

Music

Drum to the beat of Africa

Children will learn that songs sung in other languages can contain sounds that are unfamiliar to us, like the clicks of the Xhosa language. To understand that major chords create a bright, happy sound . To know that poly-rhythms means many rhythms played at once.

Science

Earth and Space—How does our solar system work?

Children will learn about the planets that make up the solar system, the relationship between the Earth, Sun and Moon and how they impact us.

Children will also investigate how shadows form and are linked to the Sun.

Maths

Place Value:

Children will learn the value of digits in numbers and to compare and order a range of numbers.

Four operations

Children will learn formal written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They will then solve problems and complete reasoning questions linked to these topics.

French

Portraits—describing in French

Children will learn the rules of using adjectives with nouns to describe a variety of portraits. They will draw on prior learning of colours.

PE

Invasion Games—Hockey

Children will develop their game play through tactical awareness. Children will be asked to analyse their own performance and the performances of others to support development.

Tag Rugby

Children will develop their game play through tactical awareness and develop a further understanding of passing and receiving techniques.
