The children will be reading 'The Pirates Next Door' and writing their own new chapter. They will be using a range of descriptive language and developing their use of time conjunctions.

We will also be writing instructions on how to play different games from the past.

Class Story time:

A range of stories linked to the theme of pirates and Christmas.

Science– How can I be a 'Super Gardener'?

We will be looking at how plants grow and will observe, sort and classify different seeds and bulbs. We will discuss and observe how plants germinate and grow into mature plants. We will set up investigations to explore what the best conditions are for plants to grow well and stay healthy. We will predict what we think will happen and will discuss what we found out.

Maths

Addition and Subtraction

We will be:

- Adding and subtracting 1 and 2 digit numbers.
- Finding 10 more and 10 less of 2 digit numbers.
- Comparing number sentences and completing missing number calculations.

Shape

- Recognising 2D and 3D shapes.
- Identifying vertices, edges and faces.
- Finding and using lines of symmetry.

History–How has the way we play changed?

We will be investigating toys and games from the past and how they are similar and/or different to those in the present. We will discuss if toys are better now or in the past and we will use timelines to sequence toys.
