As part of our Walk to School scheme, we are excited to name our teddy, Toe-Be. The name was very cleverly chosen by Alannah in Y5.

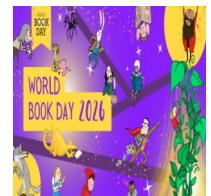


