School Uniform Policy

Please can we remind you of our school uniform expectations. Children should not come to school wearing trainers, appropriate school shoes must be worn. Any children wearing trainers to school will be asked to change into their PE pumps. Please also note that lines/patterns are not acceptable in children's hair cuts. Our school uniform consists of:

- Red jumper with logo (preferred): from school supplier
- Royal Blue Polo Shirt: from supplier/supermarket
- Grey/ Black trousers, skirt or pinafore: from any supplier/supermarket
- Black flat school shoes: from any supplier/supermarket
- PE T-Shirt: from school supplier
- Black PE shorts or joggers: from any supplier/supermarket
- Black PE pumps: from any supplier/supermarket
- Optional blue headscarf for girls in Years 5 and 6 only: from school supplier

LSCFT NHS Talking Therapies is a psychological therapy service offering a range of free talking therapies to people aged 16 and over in Lancashire and South Cumbria. 1 in 4 people in the UK will experience a mental health problem each year. Many of us go through difficult times in our lives, which can leave us feeling worried, anxious or depressed and feeling unable to cope. Talking Therapies offer a range of brief psychological interventions to support people's differing emotional needs (such as generalised anxiety issues, panic, Depression & low mood, Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder), this includes online, telephone and face-to-face treatment and therapy options. The service also offers therapy for individuals with Long-Term Conditions (such as chronic pain or cardiovascular conditions) who are experiencing anxiety or low mood. All treatment is free and people can self-refer on the website : www.lscft.nhs.uk/talkingtherapies.

Our Burnley service currently has particularly low waits for one of our therapies 'guided self help' as of April 2026. This therapy provides coping strategies for: Low mood, anxiety, stress, sleep and panic. The different therapies and waits can all be discussed further in your initial appointment.
