48 Hour Rule

The 48 hour rule requires children to stay home for at least 48 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea. This guideline prevents the spread of highly contagious viruses.

The Countdown: The 48 hour clock restarts from the exact time of the last instance of being sick or having diarrhoea.

Recovery: They must also feel completely well and have a normal temperature before returning to school.

Hygiene: Encourage regular handwashing with soap and warm water to stop the bug from spreading to classmates and family.
