

English

Older Literature—The Railway Children—Children will analyse characters and language from the book and write a diary entry in the style of one of the children.

Discussion text—impact of social media Children will discuss the positives and negatives of social media use. They will use cause and effect conjunctions to develop reasons.

Science- Living things and their habitats

Children will be learning about the need for reproduction in all living things and comparing lifecycles of various animals, including humans. We will also investigate how flowering and non-flowering reproduce by use of pollination and seed dispersal.

Maths

Place value—Children will learn to read, write, round, compare and order numbers to 10,000,000

Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division—children will learn formal written methods and develop problem solving skills.

French

Transport—Use the verb **aller** in the present tense to ask for and give information about how people travel.

Geography

National Parks of the UK

Children will locate the National Parks, learn about the physical features of them, as well as the similarities and differences between National Parks in the UK.
