

English

The children will be learning how to write simple sentences using finger spaces to separate words, capital letters to start the sentences and use full stops to finish. When reading we will be spotting and joining in with repeated language in stories and poems. To improve our understanding of characters we will practise this through role play finding out and talking about the main characters. We will also find and talk about main events.

Texts

The Three Little Pigs, information texts to help us write about our school and traditional playground rhymes such as Ibbie Obble, One Potato and Eeny Meeny

Geography

What could we do to improve our school grounds?

The children will learn to study geographical features, devise simple maps and carry out fieldwork within the school grounds.

PE

Overarm throwing and kicking a ball

The children will learn how to overarm throw and kick a ball with increasing accuracy.

Music

Superhero Sounds!

The children will explore tempo and pitch to tell a story and create a Superhero theme tune!

Science

Why are objects made from different materials?

The children will learn to recognise everyday materials and know their properties. They will sort and group objects and materials according to their properties and begin to describe those properties. They will carry out simple investigations.

Maths

The children will be reading and writing numerals to 10.

They will be counting within 10 forwards and backwards.

They will be learning one more and one less than any number within 10.

They will be comparing numbers using language such as equal, greater/more, fewer/less.

They will order numbers and groups of objects.

They will use ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd ...).

The children will add numbers within 10 and learn number bonds within 10 e.g. $2+5=7$, $3+7=10$.

RE

Does how we treat the world matter?

The children will learn about the Christian story of creation and how this fits with ideas about caring for the planet.

PSHE

What makes a good friend?

The children will learn how to make and sustain friendships. They will learn what makes a good friend and how to recognise when they feel lonely. They will learn how to resolve arguments and support friends.

Computing

Online Safety

The children will be exploring how to keep themselves safe online including how to set passwords and sharing of information. They will learn what to do if someone makes them feel sad, worried or uncomfortable online.

Art

Lovely Landscapes

Children will learn to mix primary colours to make secondary shades, explore different painting implements and make their own paintings. They will be looking at the work of artist Georgia O'Keefe.
